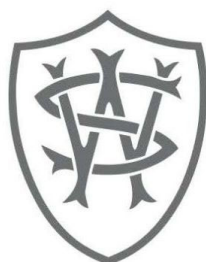

Dear Parents,

It has been a week of real achievement in the co-curricular programme. Book ended by Year 10 Parents' Evenings, the Upper School Play Don't Drink The Water performed at the RADA theatre was a real success. The cast, led by Max Pozzi and Sacha Ross, coped well with the challenge of the farce that required them to perform slapstick routines, deliver jokes and deal with the absurdities of the plot. They performed the piece with aplomb and impressed the audience with their mature performances. Miss Twomey and her team of Mrs Atkinson and Miss Webb have in the last three years given us physical theatre, the atmospheric Frankenstein and now farce. I am left wondering where we will be taken next?

One member of the cast, Max Hashem, had a very busy Wednesday. Before travelling to Fitzrovia for the second night, Max, with the 1st XV squad of boys from Year 13 to Year 11, were at Ealing Trailfinders to play Cardinal Vaughan Memorial School in the semi-finals of the Middlesex Plate. The sides were very evenly matched but Wetherby's defensive commitment was the difference between the two sides. In a match that saw the lead change a number of times, a final minute penalty from Pip Evans secured the win for WSS 30-27. It was a fantastic team performance and it was clear from the emotional reactions of the team and staff at the end how much it meant to them to reach the finals of this competition that also included Latymer Upper and St James Enfield earlier in the draw.

The final will be particularly special for the Year 13 boys who will be playing against a team they last played in the early weeks of the School, Isleworth and Syon Boys' School. It was a heavy defeat for WSS but a lot has changed since then and I am looking forward to seeing the boys try and reverse that result next Wednesday. The match kicks off at 1.00pm at [Grasshoppers RFC](#) in Isleworth – the boys, Mr Sullivan and I, would love it if you could come and join us.

### *What is the shoebox appeal?*

It has become an annual Christmas tradition for Wetherby Senior School to support West London Mission by providing supplies for many people who spend Christmas on the streets. We need your help once more to provide a shoebox (or other type of box) with some essentials for the homeless.

### *The box could include:*

- Non-perishable food items (tinned food, pasta, rice, oil, long-life milk, tea)
- Socks, hats, gloves and scarves
- Travel Cards – weekly bus passes
- Pay-as-you-go phones with SIM cards, chargers and credit
- Gift vouchers for Sports Direct (for clothes, working boots, hard hats etc.)
- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Toiletries (shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant)
- Razors
- Feminine hygiene products

### *What does the West London Mission do?*

The West London Mission assists people without homes to find accommodation and work. Last year, they helped 241 people into housing and over 2,000 clients received individual advice & support. In October, 35 people were helped into accommodation and 6 people into work.

### *How can you help?*

Please bring any items in the list above to your form tutor **before 12<sup>th</sup> December**. On 12<sup>th</sup> December, you will spend the afternoon with your form, wrapping the shoeboxes in a festive way. Some of you will also be helping to deliver the shoeboxes to WLM.
